TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The S.R.F.I. rules shall apply unless otherwise provided. Players should note the code of conduct regulations, which will be enforced.
2. Players are requested to report at The Willingdon Sports Club Squash Courts at least **THIRTY** minutes before the scheduled starting time of their match. Failure to do so may result in a walk over.

The Tournament Committee shall be the final authority regarding walkovers.
3. Matches will commence at **8.30 a.m.**
4. The Tournament Committee shall be the final authority and their decisions shall be final and binding on all issues.
5. All matches shall be best of **FIVE** games and on **ELEVEN** point per game point a rally scoring (PARS).
6. Participants must be under their age category as on 16th January, 2011. All the participants must compulsory furnish documentary proof of age (photocopy) from the principal of the School or College they are attending on the school/college letter-head alongwith the entry form, failing which their entries will not be accepted.
7. Squash balls shall be provided by the Tournament Committee.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right of refusing any entry without giving any reasons. The decisions of the Tournament Committee will, in all matters be final, including discipline and match adjudication.
9. Copies of the draws and each day's programme will be posted on the notice board of the Squash Courts.
10. All players must be clad in complete white or pastel shades including shoes with White soles (Marking soles strictly not allowed). Players must be required to make themselves available to meet reasonable request for interviews by the media.
11. Players/Parents are warned not to air their opinion on any controversial issues nor to make any derogatory remarks about fellow competitors, Officials, Referees or any related parties. Players may be disqualified.
12. No travelling or incidental expenses will be paid.
13. Eye protection is mandatory for all players.
14. A player can enter maximum in **TWO** categories. Depending upon the circumstances players will have to play matches both morning and evening. An entry fee of Rs. 100 per event must be sent along with the entry form.
15. A minium of 8 entries for each category is required for conducting Tournaments in any category. In case less than 8 entries are received the event will stand cancelled.
16. Draws would be put-up at The Willingdon Sports Club, Squash Courts by 4.00 p.m. on 10th January, 2011.
