CRITERIA FOR BEING INVITED FOR SELECTION TRIALS FOR INTERNATIONAL

SQUASH TOURNAMENTS & SELECTION PROCESS - 2010

General

1. Coaching camps / selection trials will be conducted by SRFI. These will be used as a guide for selecting players to participate in international tournaments. Participation in the selection trials/ coaching camp is compulsory for eventual selection or participation in the championship.

Criteria for selecting players for national coaching camps / selection trials

- **To represent India in Senior Championships**
Semifinalist of the National Championship
- **To represent India in Junior Championships (under 19)**
Semifinalist of the Junior National Championship
- **To represent India in Junior age group Championships (u11, u13, u15, u17)**
Semifinalists in respective age groups.

Note: The Squash Rackets Federation of India reserves the right to invite such other Indian citizens, who in their opinion, has the long term potential to excel at international levels.

Selection Process

The selection committee would select the teams to represent the country. The committee shall consist of the President / Secretary General of the federation, the consultant coach, the national coach and an eminent ex – sportsperson.

The selection committee will consider the following factors:

- a) Performance at National / International Tournaments
- b) Regional / World Rankings
- c) Performance at the selection trials / camps
- d) Physical fitness tests results
- e) Discipline on and off court
- f) Attitude during training and competition
- g) Future potential
