Subject: XI M. P. Open Squash Rackets Championship.

Dear Sir / Madam,

It is a matter of great pleasure to inform your good self that the M.P.S.R.A. will be conducting its **XI M. P. Open Squash Championship at Gwalior** from **January 28–31, 2012**. Kindly note that it is an SRFI Sanctioned Event which is being conducted in collaboration with the Lakshmibai National University of Physical Education. Further details about the Championship are as follows:

The Venue:

The Championship will be held at the newly constructed Squash Rackets Complex (three glass back wooden floor courts) of Lakshmibai National University of Physical Education, popularly known as LNUPE or Physical College. Gwalior city is well connected with railway, bus and air services. It is on Delhi-Chennai broad gauge traction. Reception arrangement at Gwalior Railway Station will be made from 27th January, morning onwards. LNUPE campus is about one (1) km away from the Railway Station & Interstate Bus Terminus, and 8 km from Gwalior Airport. Air India flights from Delhi and Mumbai arrive daily at 2:45 pm and 3:30 pm respectively. Teams/Players confirming their arrival time and mode, at least 12 hours before arrival at Gwalior, may be received at the Bus stand / Railway station / or Airport, if they so desire, otherwise, auto-rickshaws and tempos are available from outside railway platform no. 1 which charge about Rs. 30/- and Rs. 50/- respectively for the full load. Lodging & Boarding:

All outstation (outside Gwalior) teams/players will be provided accommodation by MPSRA in Mahatma Gandhi International Hostel of Lakshmibai National University of Physical Education. It will be fully furnished, but shared accommodation provided from 27th January morning onwards. MPSRA will also provide meals at the place of accommodation to all outstation teams/players. If any player/team wishes to make his/her/its own boarding and lodging arrangements, he/she/it may do so. Good Hotels are available at about one km distance from LNUPE. Local (Gwalior) players will not be provided any such facility.

Gwalior Climate:

The climate in Gwalior in January end is cold with temperatures ranging between 10-12°C in the nights and 23-25°C during daytime. So, players must bring sufficient woolen clothes.
