1. Entry Form should be fully filled with all required details, otherwise likely to be rejected. The Tournament Committee reserves the right of refusing any entry without giving any reason.
2. All Entries from teams/players belonging to M.P. State should be sent directly by Post/E-mail to: **Prof. V. K. Dabas, 76, L.N.U.P.E., Shakti Nagar, GWALIOR – 474002 (M.P.)**, Mobile: 09425122613, E-mail: drvkdabas@rediffmail.com. Entries from outside M.P. State must be sent through Squash Rackets Federation of India, by E-mail to: squashsecretariat@gmail.com. **Last Date for closing entries: January 21, 2012.**
3. All out station (out of Gwalior) entries must be accompanied with Entry Fee of Rs. 500/- per category per player redeemed through Demand Draft, payable at Gwalior in favour of: Secretary, MPSRA, Gwalior. Local players (Gwalior) will pay Rs. 200/- as entry fee. They will not be provided any boarding and lodging facilities. Entries without Entry Fee shall not be accepted. The Fee is non-refundable/non-transferable.
4. SRFI rules shall apply unless otherwise stated. Players should fully abide by the code of Conduct, Rules and Regulations.
5. All age-group participants must compulsorily furnish documentary proof of age. An attested copy from the Principal of the School/College, they are attending, or date of birth proof on letterhead with seal shall be accepted. Entries without age proof shall not be entertained.
6. A minimum of 8 entries for each category are required for conducting tournament in that category. The Tournament Committee's decision will be final and binding on these issues. However, in case of inadequate entries in any category, the candidate may be considered for immediate next age group.
7. A player can enter in a maximum of TWO categories only (own and one higher).
8. The Tournament will be played on 'knock-out' and matches on 'best of 5 games' bases with 'point a rally system' (PARS) and on 11-points per game scoring system.
9. Players will be required to report to the Courts at least twenty minutes before the scheduled starting time of their matches. Failure to do so will automatically result in a walk-over. Disciplinary action shall be taken against player/s, including non-issue of participation certificate, who give a walk-over or do not turn-up for the event without any valid reason.
10. Copies of the draws and each day's programme will be posted on the notice board at the Squash Courts. Players may be required to play more than one match in a day.
11. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final and binding in all matters including discipline, match adjudication, walk-over, dispute, protest etc.
12. Referees for the matches shall be arranged by the Tournament Committee. However, some players will be expected to refer/mark the matches.
13. The Tournament Committee shall provide the Squash Balls. The players should bring their own Rackets.
14. All players must wear non-marking gum-soled shoes and eye protectors. MPSRA will not be responsible for any injury occurred during the game.
14. Players will not be allowed to fix their matches / timings.
15. The organizers shall not pay any traveling or incidental expenses.
16. Prize money will not be paid to the player/s who is/are absent during the prize distribution function.
17. Players will be required to make themselves available to meet reasonable requests for interviews by the media and to attend official functions connected with the Tournament. On the other hand, the players are warned not to air their opinions on any controversial issue and not to make any derogatory remarks about fellow competitors, officials, referees, organizers or any other related parties.
