Rules and Conditions of Play

1. Entry form has to be fully filled with all details.
2. The S.R.F.I rules shall apply unless otherwise provided. Players should note the code of conduct regulations, which will be enforced.
3. **Players are required to report to the Tournament Office at least thirty minutes before the scheduled starting time of their match. Failure to do so will result in a walk over.**
4. The Tournament Committee shall be the final authority regarding walkovers.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games and on 11 point per game scoring system except the usage over 55 event which will be best of 3 games.
6. Squash balls shall be provided by the Tournament Committee.
7. Referees for the matches shall be arranged by the Tournament Committee.
All players will be expected to referee / mark matches.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right of refusing any entry without giving any reasons. The decisions of the Tournament Committee will, in all matters be final, including discipline and match adjudication.
9. Copies of the draws and each day's programme will be posted on the notice board at the squash courts.
10. **All players must wear Non marking Gum SOLED shoes.**
11. Players must be required to make themselves available to meet reasonable request for interviews by the media.
12. Players are warned not to air their opinions on any controversial issues nor to make any derogatory remarks about fellow competitors, Officials, Referees or any related parties.
13. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding.
14. No travelling or incidental expenses will be paid.
15. **For Junior events eye protection is compulsory.**
16. **A minimum of 8 entries for each category is required for conducting tournaments in any category. The Tournament Committee's decision will be final and binding on these issues.**
17. Prizes will not be given to the players not present on the prize distribution function.
18. All the participants must compulsory furnish documentary proof of age (photo copy) from the Principal of the school or college they are attending and the school college letter head and birth certificate alongwith the entry forms filling which their entries may not be accepted.
19. In the Professional category the professional has to work 8 hours duty to his respected club or Gymkhana attached his salary certificate to the entry form.
20. **Players are not allowed to fix their matches / timings.**
21. **Players can play in any 2 categories only.**
